

During our *reopening phases*, we are seeking to follow the State of CT outlined procedures for houses of worship and large indoor gatherings.

**Please note the following guidelines for our Sunday gatherings:**

- Beginning Sunday, Aug 16 we will only have **ONE service at 9:30am** (another service is scheduled to be added Sep 27)
- An RSVP is needed in order to attend (see directions for RSVP below)
- The RSVP option will be available each Wednesday before the weekend
- Currently, there is an 85-person limit per service (in accordance with state guidelines and taking staff into account)
  - *Note: Our service also **livestream** at 9:30am on our website under the “Services” tab, for those who are not able to attend the service*
- As per CT state guidelines, masks are to be worn
- Seating will be spread out in accordance with state guidelines
- There will be sanitizing stations set up
- All rooms will be closed except for the main auditorium and the bathrooms
- Nursery will not be offered
- Coffee will not be served
- All necessary precautions will be taken to ensure everyone's safety, to the best of our ability
- According to state guidelines for a house of worship, masks must be worn at all times while in the building - this includes during times of singing as well. Those attending are free to sing while wearing a face covering.

**TO RSVP:** (*option is available Wednesday of each week*)

1. Go to CalvaryConnect: [cefc.ccbchurch.com](http://cefc.ccbchurch.com) (do not use www.)
2. Click on “Events” (or Calendar)
3. Click on the **“Church-wide Calendar” option**
4. Click on the 9:30am service time
5. Click “Yes” (that accounts for YOUR attendance)
6. Under “Additional Guests” indicate the number of people in your family (**not including yourself**) who will be attending with you (be sure only one person per family completes the RSVP so that we do not get duplicate entries)
7. **Then click “RSVP” (in the black rectangle)**
8. Then click “outside” of the RSVP window to get back to the regular calendar and to “log out”
9. If you want to be sure your RSVP has been registered, follow steps #1- 4 and you should see your status listed as “Attending”
10. **Please note:** IF, after you submit your RSVP as “yes”, you find that your plans changed and you *will not* be attending, please go back to the calendar (steps #1- 4) and click on “Edit” (next to “attending”) so it will free up space for others who would like to attend
