Colossians 1:18

This text is about how Jesus is the founder of churches and the ultimate leader of churches.

Share with the group all the other churches of which you've been a part and discuss some of the positive characteristics of each church.

What do you think are advantages of churches with under 200 people? What do you think are advantages to churches with over 600 people?

What size church do you most enjoy/feel comfortable in?

As mentioned, Calvary has been around for 129 years.

Prior to attending Calvary, were you ever part of a new church?

What do you think are some advantages to new churches? What are some advantages to churches that have been around for many years?

When discussing what Jesus wants his staff to do, we looked at Ephesians 4:11-12. Read that verse and discuss some observations.

Did you learn anything "new" from that verse? Is there anything from that verse of which you new but were reminded?
