We understand CCS will accept students of varying religious backgrounds, but all students must comply with all behavior, dress and spiritual requirements as established from time to time by the school administration and board.

_____/_____/ We agree with the philosophy of Cornerstone Christian School and will give active support to the school program in every way possible. We will make a sincere effort to attend and participate in CCS functions.

Conduct & Standards

_____/_____/ We agree to accept and support all rules and regulations of Cornerstone Christian School and authorize the school to administer the disciplinary methods stated in the CCS handbooks. We understand the standards of the school do not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or actions, or any type of action or harassment from students or parents that are deemed disrespectful or harmful to school staff or students. We understand that parents who behave in this manner to a staff member will be asked to leave the campus and may be banned from the campus.

_____/_____/ We will expect our student(s) to comply with CCS regulations. We will withdraw our student(s) or accept the school's right to dismiss them, if we become unable to support these policies, procedures and rules. We realize the school reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not respect its spiritual standards or cooperate in the educational process of CCS. We understand that damage to school property by the student due to willful or negligent means will be directly charged to the student or parent.

_____/_____/ We give permission for our student(s) to take part in all regular school-day activities, including school sponsored trips. We release CCS from liability because of any injury at school or during any school-associated activity.

Dispute & Reconciliation

_____/_____. We understand and agree that we will make every effort to live at peace and resolve disputes with each other in conformity with the Biblical injunctions of I Corinthians 6:1-8, Matthew 5:23-24 and Matthew 18:15-20.

Therefore, we agree to submit any dispute including, but not necessarily limited to negligence, contract or statutory, we have with CCS that may otherwise lead to legal action, first to the Administrator of CCS.

Matters elevated to the School Board will be made at the Administrators request. Rules and guidelines of the Institute for Christian Conciliation (ICC) will be followed in all matters. By submitting to such CCS binding arbitration, we have chosen to follow the biblical command for the resolution of conflicts (I Corinthians 6:1-8), and in so doing, we understand that we are expressly waiving any right we may have to submit such a dispute to either a court of law or to an administrative or government body for resolution. (Copies of the ICC guidelines are available in any of our offices for parent's review.)

Medical Release

_____/_____. We, the parents/guardians, authorize Cornerstone Christian School to call emergency service (911) in case of an accident and to arrange for an emergency medical care doctor in case the parent is not immediately available. Any physician called by Cornerstone Christian School, paramedics or hospital emergency service, may treat and/or take necessary measures for the health and well being of the student. It is understood that a conscientious effort will be made to notify the parents before such action will be taken. We, the parent/guardian, will accept responsibility for the cost of any medical service, physician, or hospital care. We understand that CCS does not provide student insurance; therefore, it is the parents' responsibility to provide insurance for school related accidents.

_____ **Early Withdrawals:** Parents must give a written 30 day when withdrawing students before the end of the school year. Any family not giving a written 30 day notice, will be required to pay the tuition incurred within the next 30 calendar days following the notification of withdrawal. The tuition account balance is to be paid on the student's last day of attendance.

_____ **Past Due Accounts:** Accounts not current by the end of any given month will constitute grounds for dismissal. Accounts must be current before students will be permitted to complete quarter and semester academic requirements. CCS reserves the right to deny admission if there are unmet financial obligations to itself or to another school.

_____ **Returned Payments and Late Fees:** A service charge of \$40.00 will be charged for each unpaid/returned tuition payment. A \$20.00 late fee will be charged to accounts not current by the end of any given month.
