Early Withdrawals: Parents must give a written 30 day when withdrawing students before the end of the school year. Any family not giving a written 30 day notice, will be required to pay the tuition incurred within the next 30 calendar days following the notification of withdrawal. The tuition account balance is to be paid on the student's last day of attendance.		
Past Due Accounts: Accounts not current by the end of any given month will constitute grounds for dismissal. Accounts must be current before students will be permitted to complete quarter and semester academic requirements. CCS reserves the right to deny admission if there are unmet financial obligations to itself or to another school.		
Returned Payments and Late Fees: A service charge of \$40.00 will be charged for each unpaid/returned tuition payment. A \$20.00 late fee will be charged to accounts not current by the end of any given month.
