- 1. What does my child need to bring to school?**
Your child will need Valentine cards, one card for each student in our class.
- 2. Where do I buy Valentine cards for my child?**
School type Valentine cards can be purchased at many stores such as Wal-Mart, Target, and Dollar Stores.
- 3. How much do Valentine cards cost?**
School type Valentine cards come in a box and are very inexpensive. The school type cards come in many different styles such as Barbie, Spiderman, Clifford, Winnie the Pooh, etc. I have attached an example of what a box of school Valentine cards looks like on the back of this note.

4. What to do after you purchase the cards!

- Open the box and detach all the cards, they are perforated for easy tearing
- Have you or your child sign his/her name on all the cards
- If your cards come with envelopes you may put the cards in the envelopes if you choose-

PLEASE DO NOT ADDRESS THE ENVELOPES WITH NAMES

- It is important to put the cards back in the box and write your child's name on the front of the box because many children will bring the same cards.

- Send the box to school with your child on **February 14**.

- 5. You will need this information, so you will know how many cards your child should sign.**

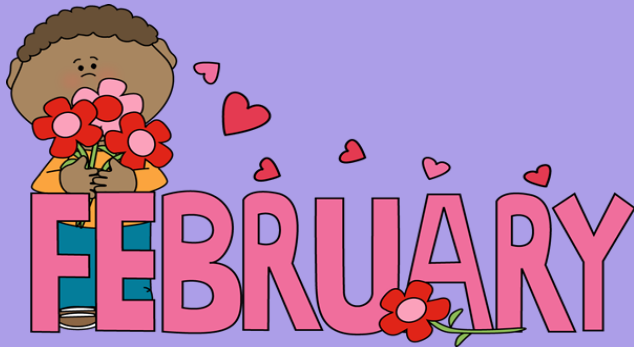
Room 1: 16 children Room 2: 9 children
