

Sunday School at Home- Week 2

(Lesson to be read aloud with your children)

[Psalm 78:40-51](#)

God protects His people

The lesson last Sunday was about God's covenant with Abraham and his descendants. Fast forward 400 years to Moses. Moses was raised up in the palace of the Pharaoh, left Egypt after killing an Egyptian guard, and went to Midian to be a shepherd. He returned to Egypt after God called to him and gave him a special job to do. Moses was hesitant to return to Egypt. He knew that he wouldn't be welcome there.

However, Moses listened to God and obeyed. His job wasn't easy. Moses had to stand before one of the most powerful men in the world and say things the Pharaoh wouldn't like to hear. Sometime God's people didn't believe him either. But Moses' trust was in the Lord and so he did not fear what other men thought.

Psalm 78:40-51 recounts the miracles the Lord performed in Egypt that showed His power and His might. These ten signs would be long-lasting reminders to God's people that God alone could save His people. God's power is the same today as it was during the time of Moses. He can deliver us from our enemies—He can be relied on to do mighty things for us just as He did for His people thousands of years ago!

Think, Talk, and Do-

1. Do you remember how God called Moses when he was in Midian? (***from the burning bush***) What did God say to Moses about where he was standing? (***to remove his sandals because it was holy ground***)
2. When Moses asked God's name what did God tell him? (***His name was Yaweh/Jehovah***) What did that special name mean? (***I AM WHO I AM***)
3. What was Moses' job when he returned to Egypt? (***to lead God's people from slavery in Egypt to the Promised Land***)

Here are a couple story pages ([story page 1](#), [story page 2](#)) about the 10 plagues that God sent against Pharaoh. After reading these story pages talk about times when we are stubborn and don't listen to God. Psalm 78:42 says, "[God's people] forgot about his power. They forgot the many times he saved them from the enemy." Talk about ways that God has protected your family and helped you during difficult times.

4. End with a prayer (Hands together, Heads bowed, Eyes closed)

Pray: Dear God- Thank you Lord, that your right hand is amazingly strong. Thank you that you protect your people with your mighty right hand! In your name we pray, Amen
