



## Small Group Questions

### 1 Peter 5

**REMINDER:** The purpose of our small groups at Cypress is to learn to love one another. We seek to do this as we: 1. Study the Bible together; 2. Discuss how to put it into practice; 3. Pray together; and 4. Live life together. Please use these questions only as they help you achieve this purpose. You will notice that these questions are structured according to the three basic principles of Bible study - observation, interpretation, and application.

1. **Sermon Link:** Read 1 Peter 5 together. What stood out to you most from these verses on Sunday?

2. **Observe – What do you see?**

The word “grace” is used three times in 1 Peter 5. Which verses include the word “grace”? Also, what do these three specific references to grace teach you about grace?

3. **Interpret – What does it mean?**

Read 1 Peter 5:5-7. These verses connect grace with humility. How would you explain to someone else the critical relationship between grace and humility that is taught in these verses?

What do you think Peter means in 1 Peter 5:12 to “stand firm” in the true grace of God?

4. **Apply – How does this apply?**

What is the Holy Spirit speaking to you about through 1 Peter 5 that you need to apply in your life?

5. **Reflection:** What have you learned over the last six weeks as we’ve studied through 1 Peter? Has your understanding of God’s grace changed? In what ways has this changed your understanding of how the Bible calls us to follow Jesus?
