



Small Group Questions

How Will They Hear? Luke 10:1-9

REMINDER: The purpose of our small groups at Cypress is to learn to love one another. We seek to do this as we: 1. Study the Bible together; 2. Discuss how to put it into practice; 3. Pray together; and 4. Live life together. Please use these questions only as they help you achieve this purpose. You will notice that these questions are structured according to the three basic principles of Bible study - observation, interpretation, and application.

1. **Sermon Link:** Read Luke 10:1-9. What were the eight observations about this passage noted during the sermon?

2. **Observe – What do you see?**

Are there other things that stand out to you in Luke 10:1-9? What other observations would you add to the eight above?

3. **Interpret – What does it mean?**

A person of peace ('son of peace,' v.6) is "someone who is not yet following Jesus but who is inviting you into their life and open to hearing more about Jesus from you." Why is it important for you to identify people like this in your life?

Think of someone in your life that you'd classify as a person of peace. After you have identified this person, what are some practical ways you could get to know them? (Hint: Think of the things Jesus might do to get to know someone.)

4. **Apply – How does this apply?**

Now that you've identified a person of peace in your life, begin praying for this person, asking God to bring them across your path and give you ways to engage with them. In addition to praying for them, what steps do you plan to take to get to know them better?
