



Small Group Questions

How Will They Hear? Acts 8:26-40

REMINDER: The purpose of our small groups at Cypress is to learn to love one another. We seek to do this as we: 1. Study the Bible together; 2. Discuss how to put it into practice; 3. Pray together; and 4. Live life together. Please use these questions only as they help you achieve this purpose. You will notice that these questions are structured according to the three basic principles of Bible study - observation, interpretation, and application.

1. **Sermon Link:** Read Acts 8:26-40 together. What stood out to you during the sermon on Sunday?

2. **Observe – What do you see?**

As you look at Phillip's actions in Acts 8:26-31, how is he a great example of the lessons we've learned so far during the "How Will They Hear?" sermon series?

List several ways Philip *slowed down* to share the fullness of the gospel with the Ethiopian man?

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3. **Interpret – What does it mean?**

To share "the good news" as Phillip did in Acts 8:35, we need to be clear on what the good news is. In your own words, write your understanding of the good news, remembering to use language a non-Christian would clearly understand.

4. **Apply – How does this apply?**

Consider the following two action steps:

- Memorize Cypress' 101-word gospel definition (cypresschurch.org).
- Pray this week for God to give you the opportunity to tell someone the good news about Jesus.
