



## Small Group Questions

### How Will They Hear? Acts 19:1-10

**REMINDER:** The purpose of our small groups at Cypress is to learn to love one another. We seek to do this as we: 1. Study the Bible together; 2. Discuss how to put it into practice; 3. Pray together; and 4. Live life together. Please use these questions only as they help you achieve this purpose. You will notice that these questions are structured according to the three basic principles of Bible study - observation, interpretation, and application.

1. **Sermon Link:** Read Acts 19:1-10 together. What stood out to you during the sermon on Sunday?

2. **Observe – What do you see?**

Paul found disciples in Ephesus who had a partial understanding of the gospel. What did they know?

3. **Interpret – What does it mean?**

We've had a lot of teaching on the gospel over the last year (See 100-word Gospel Statement at [cypresschurch.org](http://cypresschurch.org)). How would you succinctly explain the full gospel of Jesus to someone?

What did Paul do in Ephesus for 3 years (Acts 20:31) that led to "all the residents of Asia" (v.10) hearing the gospel? How did the gospel spread from 12 disciples to the whole province?

4. **Apply – How does this apply?**

How is the Holy Spirit speaking to you through Acts 19:1-10? What next steps is Jesus calling you to take to be a multiplying disciple who shares the gospel with the lost in Monterey County?
