



## Small Group Questions Colossians 3:18-4:6

**REMINDER:** The purpose of our small groups at Cypress is to learn to love one another. We seek to do this as we: 1. Study the Bible together; 2. Discuss how to put it into practice; 3. Pray together; and 4. Live life together. Please use these questions only as they help you achieve this purpose. You will notice that these questions are structured according to the three basic principles of Bible study - observation, interpretation, and application.

1. **Sermon Link:** Read Colossians 3:18-4:6. What was a take-away or key insight from the sermon?

2. **Observation - What do you see?**

Paul challenges Christians to live a life worthy of King Jesus in every sphere of life: church (3:1-17), home (3:18-21), work (3:22-4:1), community (4:2-6). What observations do you have about these four spheres?

How does the Apostle Paul instruct Christians to live for King Jesus in the following relationships:

*Wives/Husbands -*

*Employee/Employer -*

3. **Interpretation - What does it mean?**

How is the example of King Jesus washing his disciples' feet (John 13:1-20) a helpful paradigm to think through as you consider what it means to live for King Jesus in every sphere of life?

4. **Application - How does this apply?**

King Jesus isn't just worthy of some of your life but your whole life. As you consider the three spheres of life identified by the Apostle Paul in Colossians 3:18-4:6 (church, work, community), which sphere has the Holy Spirit spoken to you most about this week? What has He said to you and how will you respond to Him?
