

Small Groups Questions Exodus 15:22-17:16

1.	Read Exodus 15:22-17:16. Of everything in this passage, what stood out to you most? And taking it a step further, why do you think <i>that thing</i> stood out?
2.	Grumbling is a major theme in this passage. The idea of grumbling comes up ten times (15:24, 16:2, 16:7, 16:8, 16:9, 16:12, 17:3). What did the Israelites grumble about? And what stands-out to you about what they grumbled about?
3.	In spite of the Israelites grumbling, the LORD was super-gracious. As you scan this week's Bible passage, how does the LORD bless, provide, give, and empower the Israelites? What does this teach you about God? What does it teach you about us?
4.	In Luke 24:27, Jesus said all of Scripture is about Him. If you put your "Jesus glasses" on, so to speak, where to you see Jesus in this Exodus 15:22-17:16?
