Romans 15:14-33

1. Read Romans 15:14-33 together. What stood out to you about these verses from Sunday's sermon, the *Going Deeper* webinar, or your own reading?
2. What was it about "the gospel" (mentioned in v.16, v.19, and v.20) that compelled Paul to share it with those who *had not* heard it, and in places where *no church* was established (vv.15-21)?
3. In vv.22-29 Paul shares his plans to go to Jerusalem, then to Rome, then to Spain. He does go to Jerusalem, but he's arrested, and he ends up in Rome, but as a prisoner (Acts 21-28). He never made it to Spain. What can we learn from this?
4. Paul constantly challenges believers to pray, and to *strive together in prayer* (v.30). How might you grow in this kind of prayer with other believers from Cypress?
