Today we are receiving a Special Offering for Vacation Bible School! With 180+ children registered for VBS, this will be a monumental undertaking for HUMC. As a guideline, it costs around \$30 per child for 5 days of VBS. If you would like to 'scholarship' the cost of a student, please make your check payable to HUMC, and write "VBS" in the memo line. If giving by cash, there are offering envelopes available in the narthex or from an usher. Write your name and "VBS" on your envelope. You can also give online with your credit or debit card (see the church website, Worship Through Giving tab, and select Vacation Bible School as your fund).

A reminder to those adults volunteering at VBS (any position). To be in compliance with UMC Safe Sanctuaries, you MUST have a current background check on file with HUMC. There is a list of those whose checks are current on the Financial Secretary's office door. If your name is not on the list, you must turn in a form (available on the rack in the narthex) by Sunday, July 20 to have a background check completed in time for VBS. You may drop your completed form in the drop slot on the Financial Secretary's door. Please understand this is a requirement to protect our children--no exceptions!
