

Our Ice Cream Social and Game Night was a huge hit—tables filled with children, youth, and adults simply enjoying one another's company. These are just a few of the ongoing activities that remind us how much joy there is in being the body of Christ together.

Looking ahead, pumpkins are right around the corner! The first truckload will arrive on **September 27**, so go ahead and mark your calendars. We will need many volunteers to help unload and then to staff the Pumpkin Patch in the weeks that follow. It's always a wonderful way to meet our neighbors and raise funds for ministry.

I also want to share some exciting news from our work with Connect Church. This group has been participating in coaching sessions once or twice a month focused on Asset Based Community Development (ABCD)—a way of looking at the strengths and gifts of our church and community, and how they can connect for God's work in the world. Not only has this process helped us reflect on who we are, but it will result in Hampstead UMC receiving a **\$10,000 grant** to support a community project in 2026. You'll be hearing much more about this in the coming months.

Friends, if this summer is any indication, God is doing something wonderful and exciting among us. We don't know exactly what the fall will bring, but I believe it will be full of opportunities for growth, service, and joy. I'm grateful to be on this journey with you.
