

“What Were Jesus’ Sins?”

text: Hebrews 4:15; I John 3:5

I Peter 1:15-16 – **“¹⁵ ...be holy in all you do, just as God, the One who called you, is holy. ¹⁶ It is written in the Scriptures: (God said:) “You must be holy, because I am holy.”**”

1. Holiness is NOT something that we will possess as an inherent part of our nature; we only become holy in _____ to Christ. It is a “transferred” holiness. Only in Christ do we “become the righteousness of God”.
2. We are reminded of the holiness of God, total, unparalleled _____, not a trace of sin, **NONE!**

Hebrews 4:15 - **“¹⁵ For our high priest is able to understand our weaknesses. He was tempted in every way that we are.....but he did not sin.”**

3. The Bible says that NO human being is _____ from the effects of sin.
4. Jesus was tempted. If Jesus had ONLY been an ORDINARY man like everyone else who ever lived, then He would have been a sinner. No matter who we are, we all — **WITHOUT** _____ — commit sin and break God’s law.

Romans 3:10 - **“¹⁰ As the Scriptures say: ‘There is no one who always does what is right, not even one.’”**

Colossians 1:15,19 - **“¹⁵ Christ is the exact likeness of the unseen God. He existed before God made anything at all..... ¹⁹ for God wanted all of himself to be in his Son.”**
