

1. God calls His children to \_\_\_\_\_ to learn to live a holy life.
2. “But just as He who call you is \_\_\_\_\_, so be holy in all you do.”  
(I Peter 1:15)
3. “Dear friends, I urge you, as aliens and strangers in the world, to abstain from sinful desires, which war against your soul.” (I Peter 2:11)
4. “Do not love the world or anything in the world.” (I John 2:15)
5. Jesus died and rose again, martyrs were sawn in two, and the church has prevailed for almost 2,000 years against the gates of hell so that Christians today can live out this ever important testimony to the waiting and watching world: \_\_\_\_\_ Christians don’t dance.
6. So, what then is true holiness? Jesus said it best: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart, mind, and soul and love your neighbor as yourself ... all the law and the prophets hang on these 2 commandments” (Matthew 22:37-40).
7. Loving God \_\_\_\_\_ in my life, means that in everything I am doing I love Him first. I SEE and HEAR this world through HIS eyes and HIS ears and with HIS heart.
8. Jesus was saying that God belongs at the \_\_\_\_\_ of whatever we are doing. We, as sinners, tend to put the thing itself – or ourselves - at the CENTER.
9. Holy living finds satisfaction and fulfillment in \_\_\_\_\_ of life. That “soul satisfaction” feeds and grows a passion for life. The holy life revolves around God in EVERY place at EVERY moment. It is a life of passion, fulfillment, meaning and eternity.

18. True peace, joy, and contentment always elude those who \_\_\_\_\_ after sin.
19. Solomon found this to be true. Listen to what he had to say in Ecclesiastes 2:10-11: "All that my eyes desired I did NOT refuse them. I did NOT withhold my heart from any pleasure, for my heart was pleased because of all my labor and this was my reward for all my labor. Thus I considered ALL my activities which my hands had done and the labor which I had exerted, and behold all was vanity and striving after wind and there was NO profit under the sun."
20. Once sin has had its way, God is the \_\_\_\_\_ ONE willing to pick up the shattered pieces of your life.
21. Guilt digs at the heart of the person \_\_\_\_\_ by sin.
22. Paul wrote, "God has not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in \_\_\_\_\_." (I Thessalonians 4:7)
