Call To Worship

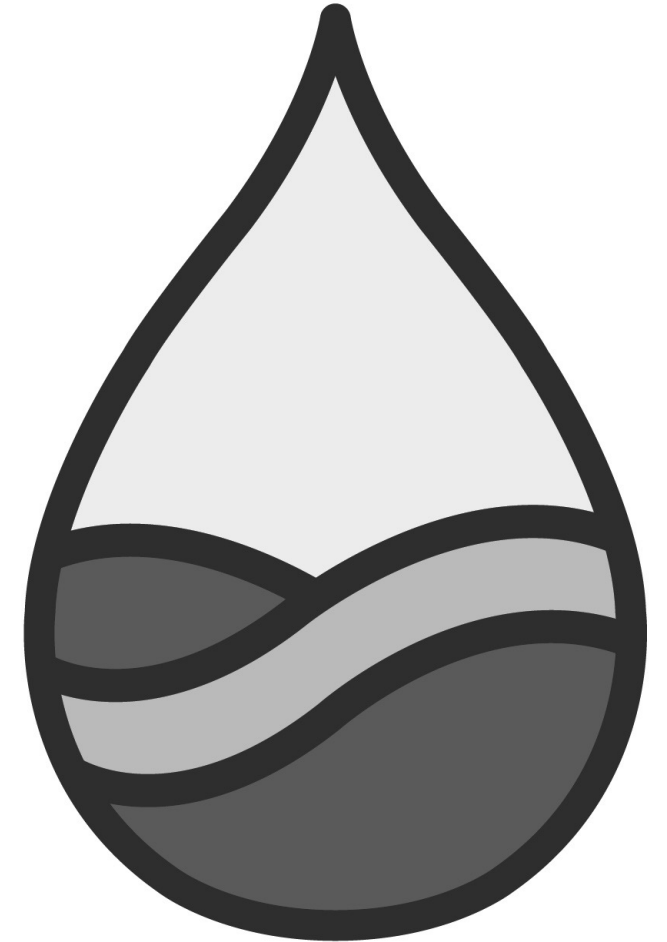
Psalm 62:5-8 (CSB)
