PACN 2019 VOLUNTEER TRAINING

PACN, Pregnancy Assistance Center North, is a local Christ-centered ministry that has volunteer opportunities for compassionate care to men and women with unplanned pregnancy or sexual health concerns. They are a non-profit pregnancy medical clinic that offers confidential services for women and men. To be a volunteer, you must go through a six part training.

- They will be holding their Volunteer Training which includes topics ranging from abortion to listening skills, domestic violence to sexual risk avoidance, and more. Trainees will observe, practice, and role play real life situations.
- Training will be held at their Woodlands Pregnancy Center located at 26464 I-45 North, Spring, TX 77386. Cost is \$50 per individual for training manual (scholarships available).
- Dates of classes are January 29 & 31, February 1, 5, 7, & 8 from 6:30 to 9:30 PM-21 hours total training (light dinner is served).
