<p><b>March 2</b> <b>Trusting in God</b> <i>This I declare of the LORD: He alone is my refuge, my place of safety; He is my God, and I am trusting Him.</i> <b>Psalms 91:2 NLT</b></p>	<p>Lord, You alone are my place of safety and protection. You are true and faithful. I place all of my trust in You. I bring all my cares, fears, and worries to You because You alone are my place of security. I trust You.</p>
<p><b>March 3</b> <b>Rescue from Hidden Traps</b> <i>For He will rescue you from every trap and protect you from the fatal plague.</i> <i>Heb. havvah-rushing calamity</i> <b>Psalms 91:3 NLT</b></p>	<p>Father, as we continue to make our dwelling in Your shelter we ask You to rescue us from every hidden trap or snare that would take us off the path that You have prepared for us, that would cause us to become entangled in sin, or lead us astray in any way. In Jesus' name we ask You to protect us from every plague and calamity.</p>
<p><b>March 4</b> <b>Protection</b> <i>He will shield you with His wings. He will shelter you with His feathers.</i> <b>Psalms 91:4a NLT</b></p>	<p>Father, we ask in Jesus' mighty name that You would keep us in the shelter of Your protection. Thank You for such a beautiful picture of Your loving provision of safety and refuge that we can place our trust in You in these extreme times we live in.</p>
<p><b>March 5</b> <b>Faithful Promises</b> <i>His faithful promises are your armor and protection.</i> <b>Psalms 91:4b NLT</b></p>	<p>We trust You alone because we know that You alone are the true and faithful God! Because Your promises are true and we make it a priority to learn them; they are our shield and we rely on You for our protection.</p>
<p><b>March 6</b> <b>No Fear</b> <i>Do not be afraid of the terrors of the night, nor fear the dangers of the day,</i> <b>Psalms 91:5 NLT</b></p>	<p>Father, because we dwell in Your secret place and trust You to be our place of safety we ask You to deliver us from all our fears. Teach us to trust You more, to not be afraid of anything in the night, or any danger during the day in Jesus' name.</p>
<p><b>March 7</b> <b>Safety</b> <i>Nor dread the plague that stalks in darkness, nor the disaster that strikes at midday.</i> <b>Psalms 91:6 NLT</b></p>	<p>Father, we thank You that no matter what is happening around us we can continue to live in Your presence and find safety. You are our refuge and fortress. We go to bed at night trusting You and we wake up each morning trusting in Your grace for each day. Oh how I love You!</p>

<p><b>March 8</b> <b>Family Safety</b> <i>Though a thousand fall at your side, though ten thousand are dying around you, these evils will not touch you.</i> <b>Psalms 91:7 NLT</b></p>	<p>Father, thank You for such an awesome promise! In Jesus' name I ask You to make this promise a reality in my life, for my children and grandchildren. Father, I pray for our G'Church children and families as they go about their lives that You would protect each and everyone of them in Jesus' name.</p>
<p><b>March 9</b> <b>Free From Sin</b> <i>If you make the LORD your refuge, if you make the Most High your shelter, no evil will conquer you; no plague will come near your dwelling.</i> <b>Psalms 91:9-10 NLT</b></p>	<p>Father, I thank You that by living in close contact and communion with You evil cannot conquer us, but through Jesus we can live in dominion over sin! <p><b>March 12</b> <b>Supernatural Protection</b> <i>The LORD says, "I will rescue those who love Me. I will protect those who trust in My name. Ps 91:14 NLT Because he is lovingly devoted to Me, I will deliver him.</i> CSB</p>	<p>Father, Oh how I do love You. You are so good to us. I thank You for all the times You have rescued me from trouble and for the many times You have saved me from danger, suffering, difficulty or sickness that I didn't even know about. I bless You for the wisdom that comes from You to make good decisions. <b>I will trust You all the days of my life!</b></p>
<p><b>March 13</b> <b>Answer Our Prayers</b> <i>When they call on me, I will answer; I will be with them in trouble. I will rescue them and honor them.</i> <b>Ps 91:15 NLT</b></p>	<p>Father, we call on You and bring all of our troubles to You. We trust You to answer each and every one of our prayers. We ask You to be with us and rescue/deliver us from any danger. We ask You to strengthen our souls and let us know You in a more intimate way. May we live fully in Your grace.</p>

I ask that as long as I am alive that I would be productive in Your Kingdom And a blessing to those around me. "I would have lost heart, unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living." Psalms 27:13</p>
<p><b>March 15</b> <b>You Are Faithful</b> <i>It is good to proclaim Your unfailing love in the morning, Your faithfulness in the evening,</i> <b>Psalms 92:2 NLT</b></p>	<p>Father, as I wake up in the morning I remember Your kindness and love and speak words of thankfulness. As the sun sets and all through the night I will proclaim, You are so faithful! Your love overwhelms me and I am so glad to be in relationship with You. I love You, Abba.</p>

May we hear Your voice <u>above all others</u> and live confident and secure in You in Jesus' name. Help us as parents to let our children know that they are God's beloved child and nothing can take that love away from them.</p>
