The need for the Gospel can be seen in relation to the darkness that is evident on almost every street corner with the presence of Hindu temples, idols, and Mosques. While their religious activities are relatively peaceful, we experienced some opposition from Muslim leaders, especially in their attempts to prevent sharing the Gospel in the schools. But, God was faithful and kept the doors open for us to share the Gospel. Praise God!

We're thankful for the team that God brought together. Each member demonstrated team unity, teachable spirits, servant's hearts, and a deep passion for the lost. They worked hard and sacrificed their time preparing for the trip and serving on the mission. They stepped out in faith to trust God to meet their needs.

The steel pan is the national instrument of Trinidad. Our American team played this unique instrument, learned the music, and used the steel pan as a platform to share the Gospel in Trinidad. This was especially noted and appreciated by the Trinidad people. For us, it was a matter of, "I have become all things to all men, that I might by all means save some." 1Cor 9:22

We're also thankful for the local pastors who came alongside us, prayed, encouraged, and followed up with discipleship of the new believers.
