Overview

The Women's Ministry exists to help ladies grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ and with one another. This ministry facilitates Bible studies, organizes fellowship events, promotes discipleship opportunities, and engages in prayer. The purpose of this ministry is to glorify God by meeting the spiritual and even sometimes physical needs of women; ladies are taught to love God and to love one another.

Currently, there are weekly Bible studies that meet at the church and other locations around town. There are also other events such as picnics, dinners, conferences and retreats that occur on a semi-annual basis. The Women's Ministry is always looking for ladies to join the ranks of those helping, serving, and leading.

- A desire to learn and grow through the study of God's word in a group setting of other sisters in Christ.
- A heart to serve alongside other godly women.
