

Power Couples: The Original Power Couple

1. This series is called "Power Couples". What is a power couple that you feel has been particularly influential? Why?
2. Adam and Eve got some things right: They knew what they were about (purpose), they walked with God & they had no shame with each other. Is there one of these that you feel more significance than the others? Why/why not?
3. Adam and Eve got some things wrong: They didn't talk about their fears and doubts with God or each other, they trusted their reason over God's truth (declaration), and they perfected the blame/shame game. Which of these resonated with you and why?
4. The legacy of Adam and Eve is a human nature that is inescapably influenced by sin and creation that is suffering under the curse. What are some ways that you see sin expressing itself through the brokenness of creation?
5. Many blame God when they encounter suffering that is a result of the curse on creation. How might this idea be a different version of the same one Eve entertained in the garden? What are some ways to address the suffering we see because of the curse?
6. Jesus is the solution to the problem of sin. Have you come to realize this? If so, when did you come to realize this for yourself personally? How has your life changed in light of the presence of Jesus in your life?
7. What do you want your legacy to be? What do you hope people will think of when they remember your life?
