- 1. Given some of what was shared in the sermon, would you rather...
  - a. Go white water rafting or canoeing down a lazy river?
  - b. Climb a climbing wall or watch someone climb a climbing wall?
  - c. Be a teacher of the Bible or use a different spiritual gift to help someone live in alignment with the Bible (what other spiritual gift would you use, and how would you use it)?
- 2. What do these passages have in common: Matthew 7:15-20; 2 Corinthians 11:12-15; 2 Peter 2:1-3? Identify what the warnings are for each passage. How can we ensure that we won't be led astray from the truth?
  - a. Jeremy read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. Read the same passage and go through 2 Timothy 4:4. How have you seen this in our day and age (what are myths that people turn to)?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 13 in its entirety. How well do we love as a church? How well do you love as individual Christians? How might we improve our ability to love in word and deed (1 John 3:18)?
- 4. Hebrews 4:12-13 is a great passage about the power of God's Word. Has God used His Word in your life like this passage says it can be used? Share your stories.
  - a. James 1:22-25 supports what Jesus said in Matthew 7:24-27. What do these two passages teach us are the benefits to living in alignment with God's Word?
- 5. HDG's are our best environments to help everyone stay focused on our Central Ministry Focus: *Guiding people through teaching and intentional relationships to live in alignment with the whole truth of God's Word*. Who can we invite to be a part of our HDG so more people can be guided?
  - a. What hinders people from joining HDG's? How can we break down the barriers?
