John 4 –Worshiping in Spirit and in Truth

1. Pastor Kyle talked about the importance of your spirit (heart) engaging in worship to God. He talked about our emotions playing a role in worship. Why or why not is this important?
  
2. Jesus pursued the woman at the well. He engaged with her even though she was living in sin and far from God. Can you relate? Have you ever felt God pursue you even in your darkest times? What would you say to someone who feels like they are alone and that no one cares for them?
  
3. Pastor Kyle said, “Cooperate worship plays a vital role in rejuvenating our hearts for the Lord. Do you believe this to be true? (Hebrews 10:24-25)

**Honest question:** Are there things in your life that take priority over corporately worshiping together on a Sunday? (Yard work, sports, travels, etc)

4. In order to worship God in truth, we need to have a correct understanding of who God is and what He has done for us. This truth that we know of God will allow our hearts/spirit to be moved in worship as well. Worshiping in Spirit and in truth is what God desires from us. What in our lives needs to change in order for us to do this?
