Luke 2 Sermon Discussion Question

1. Read Luke 2:1-39.
2. What are some Christmas traditions that your family has used to mark the holiday?
3. When you think about the meaning of Christmas, what do you think are the most important aspects of Christmas?
4. The Sunday message focused on 4 aspects of the message about the birth of Christ—the covenants. The four covenants mentioned in the Old Testament focus on the rescue plan of God to save humanity from the curse of sin and death: The Adamic, The Abrahamic, The Davidic, and The New Covenant. God's plan to rescue humanity through one man, one family, one nation, and one sacrifice. If you had been in charge of announcing the long-foretold birth of the Messiah, how would you manage the Promotional Campaign of the birth of Christ?
5. What do your answers to the above question say about your understanding of how to influence people? How is that similar or different from God's promotional campaign for the birth of His son?
6. The response to the message was examined through 5 groups or individuals: The Angels, the shepherds, Simeon, Anna, and Mary. Those responses were summarized in 7 ways:
 1. Praise?
 2. See for yourself?
 3. Tell others?
 4. Glorify God?
 5. Bless and praise God?
 6. Give Thanks?
 7. Treasure in your heart?
