1. The phrase “Growth Pathway” implies that there is a destination we are headed toward. What is your favorite destination place?

2. Would you say you are more of a drifter or a seeker after God’s call on your life? Explain.

3. Of the four signs that tell us we are on the Growth Pathway, which one is your strongest and which one is your weakest? Explain why you think that is.
 - What can we do as an HDG to truly motivate and encourage each other to stay on the pathway?

4. Read Romans 12:4-5, 1 Corinthians 12:4-13, and Ephesians 4:11-16 and discuss what these teach about connecting to each other for the sake of growth in learning what God’s call is on each of our lives.

5. The author of Hebrews gives a pretty stern warning in Hebrews 5:11-14. Figure out what the warning is and how it is remedied according to that passage.

6. Three obstacles to our staying on the Growth Pathway were spelled out in the outline. What were they and which obstacles seem to get in your way to understanding God’s call on your life?

7. Jeremy helped to describe Philippians 2:12-13 by telling a story about a tom cat from his growing up years named Leon. How have you experienced what v.13 describes? Read Romans 6:11-14 and discuss the keys those verses bring out to allowing God to work in us.

8. Do you agree or disagree with this statement, “God’s call on my life will not be fully known until I stand before Him one day at His judgment seat.” Explain.
 - If that is true, how do we avoid discouragement that we won’t know fully what God’s call on our lives is even though we are seeking to discover it?
