

Sermon Discussion Questions
David: Flight or Fight
2 Samuel 12:1-13, Psalm 32 & 51
February 25, 2018

1. When we sin, we have the option to flee from God or run toward Him. Why does running away from God seem to be our natural tendency?
2. God used the prophet Nathan to speak truth into David's life. Do you have anyone you have given access to speak truth into your life?
 - a. If so, when is the last time that person did so? If it has been a while, why is that the case?
 - b. If not, who is someone you could intentionally talk with about freely and truthfully speaking hard truths to you?
3. During the year David "kept silent" (Psalm 32:3) he was miserable. When you flee from God, how do you feel? What physical, spiritual, or emotional symptoms do you have that indicate you have a broken relationship with God or someone else?
4. Have you ever ran from God for a period of time? What was it that got you to the point of fighting for him, instead of running from Him?
5. What is more difficult confessing our sins to God, or to another person?
6. Share a story about at time you covered or hid your sin. When you confessed it, how did it go? How does that impact your feelings on confession today? Has that situation made it easier or more difficult to come to the Lord with confession?
