What Role Can You Play?
Luke 19:28-35

- 1) if Jesus was your football coach, what position would you be currently playing?
 - a) Would you consider yourself a backup, starter, or pro bowler at the position Jesus is asking you to play?

- 2) Jesus asks us to be willing to go unnoticed in our going, doing, and giving. Yet, there may be times it is beneficial to share about your service in God's Kingdom. When would it be helpful to share about what you are doing?
 - a) How can you determine when you are sharing to brag about yourself vs when you are sharing to build up the Kingdom?

- 3) In Matthew 25:31-46 Jesus tells us he will judge us based on how we treat those who are: hungry, thirsty, naked, strangers, and in prison. With that list, we could be serving 24/7. How can we determine who and how often we should "give" of ourselves to others?

- 4) Self-Reflection: Do you have any spiritual disciplines you do that you do in secret?
 - a) What would some examples look like? What is the purpose of doing things for Jesus in secret?

- 5) In The Great Commandment, Jesus told us we are to love God, and to love our neighbors as ourselves. How do you strike a balance between these two commandments?
