I Know You Know This. But...

Titus 3
June 24, 2018

1. Think back to when you were a kid. Was there anything that your parents had to constantly remind you of (e.g., do your homework, practice your instrument, feed the animals, etc.)? What was it, and how did it make you feel when they gave those reminders?
 - When you hear reminders in church would you say you respond to them by (pick one):
 - Ignoring them
 - Hearing them, but really not doing anything different
 - Hearing them and praying to the Lord to help you live them out
 - Make adjustments in your life to live in line with them (always, most of the time, or on occasion)
 - Fight against them, like “No one is going to tell me how to live,” or “I already know that and I don’t need to hear it again.”

2. Rate the motivation factor (1-10, 1 being not motivate and 10 being super motivated) of Titus 3:3-7 in wanting to inspire others to know and live in the truth of those verses. Explain why you picked that number.
 - How can we inspire others to live in the light of how good the Lord is?
3. There were some pretty harsh words Paul used in Titus 3:10-11 regarding those who cause division. How do we carry this kind of a directive out while at the same time being what Titus 3:1-2 tells us to be?
4. Of the four practical ways we work at being inspiring (the last 4 things on your outline, which one is the most difficult for you to live out and why? Which one is the easiest?)
 - How are we doing as an HDG at building friendships (Titus 3:12)
 - How are we doing at helping in ministry (Titus 3:14)
 - What can we do to ensure people know they matter (Titus 3:15)
 - When Paul wrote, “Grace be with you all” (Titus 3:15b), what do you think he is wishing, and how do we experience it?
 - Do we wish that for one another? Do we wish this for the lost in our community?
