

Sermon Discussion Questions
James: Live It Out
James 2:12-26
July 1, 2018

- 1) We are right in the heart of summer. Are you into your “summer routine” yet? How does summer change your daily schedule? How do you view this change?

- 2) Brian started out with a statement: “We are educated beyond our obedience.” What are your thoughts about this statement?
 - a) Do you agree with it in terms of yourself, small group, the church?
 - b) What is a healthy balance of growing in education and walking in obedience?

- 3) Hebrews 11 is thought of as the “Hall of Faith.” Read Hebrews, chapter 11 and discuss why each of the people mentioned received recognition in the Hall.
 - a) How does this chapter connect to the discussion from James 2?

- 4) It is often during a crisis (natural disaster, illness, death, etc.) that people are more likely to be receptive to hearing about, and receiving, Jesus. How can we combine our faith and deeds, and fulfill God’s purpose for our lives, during these hardships?

- 5) Brian closed with a question: Would you sign up for the classroom study, or the community service project? How would you respond to that question?
