**Injustice at Home and Abroad**  
Micah 1-2  
September 4, 2016

1. What are some injustices that you see in the world around us? Do we all agree on what are injustices? Why or why not?
2. Have you ever had an injustice against you? (Would you feel comfortable sharing?) How did it affect you and/or those around you?
3. How do these passages hit you – Psalm 41:1; Proverbs 29:7, 10; 31:8-9. Can you think of other passages that promote justice?
4. Micah responded to the injustices in his day and age (Micah 1:8-10). How do you respond to injustices when you hear about them? (See your outline—what did you write in the blank? Would you change what you wrote?)
5. Micah brought it closer to home when he spoke against the greed of his day (Micah 2:1-2). How does greed manifest itself today?
6. “How much is enough?” was a question in the outline. How do you answer it?
  - a. Do you agree or disagree with this statement and why, “Most Christians in America have the sin of greed in their hearts”?
7. Another injustice is that people are fed lies and they believe them. What are some common lies in our society? What are some common lies we as Christians must speak the truth into?
8. The last question on the outline is “Am I in a right place with Him?” Are you in a right place with Jesus? Why is it important to be in a right place with Him?
