(February 21, 2024)

The February 21, 2024, stated Session meeting was held in the board room following soup night with Julie Dovey being absent and excused. All other elders were present in addition to the moderator, the Rev. Emily McCachren. The devotions were led by Elder LeeAnne Kendall using the Scripture, Psalm 110, Standing Ready to Help. She then opened the meeting with prayer.

The average worship attendance for the month of December was 48 in person and online. Thirty-Five persons received Communion on January 14, 2024.

Pastor Emily submitted a written pastor's report showing her activities for the past month. With her worship service preparation, she has focused on the importance of authentic worship that captivates each person's body, mind, and soul.

The Youth Group leaders are trying a new outreach model via TikTok which can be viewed on social media.

Pastor Emily is seeking midweek program leaders for next year. Her anticipated leave now includes June 2<sup>nd</sup> and July 15-21 as vacation time; April 8-14 and May 20-23 as continuing education and April 1 as Spiritual Renewal.

Elder John K Johnston was elected clerk of session for a one-year term. Elder April Leese was welcomed to her first session meeting as ruling elder.

It was noted that five new members were welcomed to the congregation on February 11, 2024: four by reaffirmation of faith and one by profession of faith.

Session continues to work on methods, activities and programs that can be initiated for the growth of

the congregation and to provide discipleship to the community. A separate work session is planned for the session to complete the development of these plans. A congregational meeting will be planned after Lent to approve the newly revised church bylaws.

The session reorganized the working committees changing some chairperson positions. Elders John K Johnston and Richard Rotz were elected to serve as the Elder Commissioners to the March 11, 2024, Carlisle Presbytery Meeting at Middle Spring church.

A scout room usage request was approved to hold a school bus instructor training session on April 13, 2024. The use of the sanctuary was approved for the ministerium to hold the community Good Friday noon service. A National Tartan Day observance will be held April 7, 2024, where each clan is invited to wear their tartan and join in the "Calling of the Clans." All Scots are invited to wear their tartan and celebrate our common Scottish heritage.

An Investment Committee was formed with Elder and church treasurer Julie Dovey as chair and Wayne MacDonald and Stanley Kerlin as members. The 2024 per capita payment to presbytery was authorized and a \$2000 pledge for general mission was approved. Usher responsibilities for the month of March were appointed. Session was informed by the trustees that flu replacements are necessary for the manse and the church chimneys. The total estimate of \$9000 was not budgeted but is a necessity.

The meeting adjourned with prayer by the moderator at 8:55 pm.




