Please complete the attached using the following format example:

1. Start with an Encouraging Scripture and include the citation.

Isaiah 40:31 – *"But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint."* (ESV)

2. Share with her how she has touched your life. (We all have a Lady Ke story. It can be a funny memory you share.)

Lady Ke,

You have shown me what it truly looks like to serve while waiting on the Lord for strength. I remember when I was going through a difficult season and you called me "just because." You didn't know how much I needed that call, but God did. Your words reminded me that I was seen, valued, and never alone. Your quiet strength and unwavering faith continue to inspire me to press forward, even on hard days.

3. End with a prayer.

Father God, thank You for the gift of our First Lady. Renew her strength daily. When she pours out to others, fill her back up in abundance. Cover her mind with peace, her heart with joy, and her home with Your presence. Let her always feel how deeply she is loved and appreciated. In Jesus' name, Amen.

4. Sign your name so she knows who's praying for her.
