

# Salvation Road

**God is the creator and ruler over all.**

**Romans 1:20-21**

“For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse. For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened.”

**No one is righteous.**

**Romans 3:10**

“...as it is written: ‘None is righteous, no, not one...’”

**We have all sinned and fallen short of His standard of perfect, holy righteousness.**

**Romans 3:23**

“...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God...”

**The penalty for sinfulness has already been set; but, God has provided a gift of eternal life through grace.**

**Romans 6:23**

“For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

**John 14:6**

“Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’”

**God’s love is so great for us that He gave His only son as a sacrifice for the sins of all humanity.**

**John 3:16-18**

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.”

**Romans 5:8**

“...but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

**Repenting of your sins, confessing Jesus Christ as Lord, and believing (placing your trust in) in Him for the forgiveness of your sins provides you with salvation.**

**2 Corinthians 7:10**

“For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death.”

**Romans 10:9-10**

“...because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.”

**Ephesians 2:4-10**

“But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved— and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.”

**There is only ONE way to receive salvation: Faith alone in Jesus Christ alone.**

**Matthew 7:13-14**

“Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few.”

**Romans 10:13**

“For ‘everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.’”

**Revelation 21:4-6**

““He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.’ And He who was seated on the throne said, ‘Behold, I am making all things new.’ Also he said, ‘Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.’ And He said to me, ‘It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end.’”
