DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



RECAP

In the second week of this series, we dove deep into salvation itself and what it actually takes to get saved. We may think we have that locked down, but a teaching of Jesus should cause us to pause long enough to be sure.

MTVGROUP QUESTIONS

1. Today we're talking about salvation and what it takes to get saved. Our understanding on that may be different based on our backgrounds. Take a few minutes to discuss your religious background and what you understood (or didn't) growing up about what it takes to get saved.
2. Read Matthew 7:21-23. How unsettling is it to picture Jesus telling a bunch of religious people who are sure that they're getting into heaven that "I never knew you"? In your life, have you ever been absolutely sure of something, only to find out later that you were absolutely wrong? (If so, share your story). How concerned should we be about getting salvation right?
3. Josh shared three false views of what it takes to get saved. Discuss these three and any other false views that you've encountered in life:
 - Magic Spell - something where you have to get the words and emotions just right
 - Spiritual Shower - something you have to do every time you mess up
 - Get Out of Hell Free Card - something that allows you to do whatever you want with no eternal consequences
4. Read Mark 1:14-15. Jesus invites people to believe and repent. Talk about your understanding of how repentance defines real faith. What are some examples you've seen of actionable faith in your life?
5. Getting saved is not completing a ritual, it is commencing a relationship (big idea for the week). How has your relationship with Jesus changed you?

NEXT STEPS

Read Galatians 5:22-24 as a group and spend time praying for each other that these fruits would be more and more evident in your lives this week.
