4. Josh finished with 7 Ways to Find God This Week. As you discuss these seven steps together, which one do you think will be the most effective to you? Which ones do you think you need the most?
 - Get in the Word.
 - Be still.
 - Discover your spiritual pathway.
 - Repent.
 - Love others.
 - Walk in the Spirit.
 - Repeat daily.
