
Descend Like a ...

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:



BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Jesus' resurrection gives us hope for eternal life.

- Who can we tell about Jesus' death and resurrection?


FAMILY ACTIVITY:



FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:


- What is temptation?


