U.S. Donors: US. donors can now receive a charitable receipt for tax purposes by making cheques out to Clearwater College U.S., an affiliate organization with whom we have a ministry partnership agreement. Simply include a note stating your donation is for Clearwater College Canada. They will then transfer the funds to us and issue you a receipt early in 2017 for the 2016 tax year.
