Dear Friends of Clearwater College,

Greetings in the wonderful name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

The 2018 fall college term has already been exceptional in many ways. The student body is spiritually passionate and their devotion to Christ is evident through their participation in services, their attentiveness in classes, and their care one for another. Animated conversations and meaningful sharing fill our dining room several times a day as students gather for meals or for the morning coffee break. At one table you might hear a deep theological discussion, at another a humorous story, and at another you may see a quick after-meal table game.

One highlight of the fall was the World Religions course. In this course, students learn the differences between Christianity and other major faiths that are now a regular part of the North American landscape. By holding this course in Edmonton, students have opportunity to tour a mosque, a Sikh temple, a Hindu temple, and sometimes a Jewish synagogue or a Mormon temple. The teacher, Steve Hawkins, is a seasoned missionary with Operation Mobilization. He speaks 13 languages and has worked with people of other faiths most of his life.

A second highlight of the fall was the ministry of Pastor Denzel Fenn during our fall Spiritual Emphasis Days. His insightful and powerfully preaching of God's word was deeply challenging and particularly relevant for pursuing God and deepening intimacy with Him. The impact of his messages will be felt for many months and years to come.

We are especially excited about what God is doing in and through our sister institution, Clearwater College, Nagaland. One exciting development is that computer technology has enabled us to enhance their programs with live teaching from Canada. I've personally had the joy of teaching classes to Naga students via Skype twice each week. More significantly, as the Naga students remain faithful in reaching out to surrounding villages, people continue to come to faith in Christ and miracles continue to happen. A fruitful harvest field indeed!

We ask that you continue to stand with us during this opportune time. We stay committed to making a difference in the lives of people through our college programs, camps and retreats, involvements in local churches, and through our outreach and mission activities. Likewise, we continue to trust God to make this possible as He moves the hearts of people to attend, to pray, and to support financially.

It is no secret that we live in challenging times both spiritually and financially. There are many needs in the world today and Clearwater College is one of many ministries that depend on the support of donors to fulfill their mission. It is people like you that stand with us in prayer and financial support that have brought us to where we are today and enable us to keep on touching lives for
