



Personally - as disciples of Christ, to strive to acquire knowledge and progress in spiritual disciplines (II Peter 3:18). To be consistent in conduct, moral excellence and growth in the graces of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23), and for spiritual ministry so as to benefit others (Ephesians 4:14-16).

Toward Leadership - pray for them, follow them as they submit to Christ and guard their reputations (Hebrews 13:7,17).

Toward the Body - to cultivate and cherish love for all, to pray for and with them, to visit and sympathize with those in affliction, to admonish each other privately and affectionately for faults and improprieties, to accept with grace the admonition of a brother or sister in Christ, to strive by all proper means to promote one another's spiritual welfare and unity within the church (James 1:27; 5:16; Ephesians 4:32; Romans 15:14).

Toward Unbelievers - to be exact in fulfilling obligations and carrying out promises, to live in a peaceable and neighborly manner, to perform acts of kindness and share the gospel of Christ with them (Romans 12:18).

Toward the Church - to be involved in some form of ministry as the Holy Spirit directs (Corinthians 12:5,11), to be faithful in attendance at the church's regularly scheduled gatherings (Hebrews 10:24-25) and to provide for the financial support of the ongoing ministry of the church (I Corinthians 16:1-2).
