5. What did the crossing of the Jordan do for Joshua's leadership?
6. What would the success and prosperity look like in the context of Joshua 1:8? (very key point!)
7. How does Joshua 1:8-9 apply to us today?
8. Do you need to be encouraged to memorize, keep hidden in your heart, God's Word? How can you help others? Ps 119:11, 97
9. What has the Lord taught you in this lesson?
