Light Answers Darkness
Luke 11:29-36

Darkness. No one likes the dark. And most Christians don't get excited about the darkness of the world. The rejection of God's good news and the trouble the enemy causes. It's dark.

READ: Luke 11:29-32

1. Jesus' crowd was growing. Why did He call that generation evil? What was wrong with asking for another sign?
2. What was the sign of Jonah? Read Matt 12:40.
3. What was unique about Nineveh?
4. Why did the Queen of Sheba travel to see Solomon? (for her story, read 2 Chronicles 9:1-12) Why did Jesus mention this?

READ: Luke 11:33-36

5. What's wrong with the song, "This little light of mine"? Right! There's NOTHING little about this light we have within us!
6. How was God seen as light in the OT?
7. What does Jesus say about Himself in John 8:12?
8. How does this fit with Matthew 5:14-16, Eph 5:8 and Phil 2:15?
9. What's keeping my light from shining? How will I ask God to shine through me?

READ: 2 Corinthians 3:18 – 4:6

10. The heart of our mission is to be the light of Christ to a world where Satan has blinded eyes. Let's be diligent about praying for the work of God, through our lives, our church, throughout our city and around the world.

Remember: If I'm to be His light, then I can expect I'll be put in some dark places, places that need His light.
