1. When the lawyer asked Jesus what he could do to inherit eternal life, why did Jesus direct him to the Law? Read Deuteronomy 6:3-6 and Lev 19:17-18.
2. What is meant by “coming to Jesus on His terms”?
3. Why were the actions of the Samaritan so shocking to the Jews?
4. Who is your neighbor? What do you need to do for your neighbor?
5. Why does being a neighbor involve sacrifice?

6. What are the implications of loving your neighbor as yourself?

7. How does loving God work out in relation to the four aspects of human life listed: heart, soul, strength and mind?

8. How is Jesus' story of redemption reflected in the story of the Good Samaritan?

9. Are you about what Jesus is about? Our lives are given to us so we can honor God and serve Him. Let's do that with all that we have!! This is our calling.

Pray for one another as together we step into the hard places and help those around us. Their greatest need is always the gospel, but sometimes the need to show love by our sacrifice is what the Lord may use so they'll hear the gospel.
