

“God is on the Throne”

Daniel 11

March 4, 2018

There is nothing God doesn't know. Whether we see it as history or prophecy, God's truth is evident. Daniel 11 has 135 known fulfilled prophecies. And there's more to come!

1. Recall from Daniel 10:14 the purpose of the vision given to Daniel by the angel.
2. According to Zechariah 2:8 and Deut. 32:8-10, how is God's love for Israel described?

Daniel 11 has 2 main sections: 1-35 has already been fulfilled; 36 – 45 is yet to be fulfilled.

- Already fulfilled: Persian empire, with four kings mentioned (vs 2) 530 b.c. – 465 b.c.
 - Greek empire, from Alexander to Antiochus Epiphanes (vs 3-35) 336 b.c. – 164 b.c.
3. Why did God tell us all this? What good is it to know the prophecy that Daniel received and now look back and know it is actual history?
 4. Are there areas in your life where you wonder if God is in control? If He is actually in control as we say He is, how does that help me see my situations differently?
 - Not Yet fulfilled: The Antichrist (vs 36-45)

Remember, this is all one prophecy given by the angel (Gabriel) to Daniel in chapters 10 – 12. It's not sequential.

5. What do we know of the antichrist from these passages?

- Daniel 7:8, 19-27
- Daniel 9:26-27
- Daniel 11:36-45

6. See what Jesus said about his coming in Matthew 24:15.

God was faithful to Israel's past and we have the word of prophecy that He will be faithful to fulfill the rest.

7. What is there in your life right now that you need to “turn over” to Him and trust Him with? Trust always requires action.

As we conclude with Daniel 12:1-4 we know there's a “Lamb's Book of Life” with the names of His people. (Luke 10:20 and Rev 20:12) Who will you invite to join you for Easter Sunday, (April 1) so they too can have the opportunity to have their name written down?
