5. Religious people often think their good works are making points with God. How would you answer them?

6. What is our need that Jesus came to take care of?

7. Do we deserve His grace/mercy? Let's thank Him for His gift of grace!

8. This week especially be praying for the services at Grace and for lost people, especially our guests to hear of God's love and not miss the opportunity to receive His gift.
