1. Pastor Mark has shared before about his own mom. What can you recall about her?
2. How was your Mother's Day, great or difficult? Speak to it as you would like.
3. What does the scripture teach us about honoring God?
 - How does 1 Chronicles 16:8-36 help us in knowing 'how to honor God'?
 - Why is John 5:18, 22-23 so important, especially when we want to be faithful at honoring God in our current culture?
4. How do the first four commandments speak to honoring God? Exodus 20:1-11
5. What are the challenges you face in faithfully honoring the Lord God? And what are some ways we can help each other as we together want to bring honor to the Lord?
6. What does "in the Lord" mean in Eph 6:1-4? Why is this so important for both child and parent to understand? How might this help our parenting?

Sensitivity matters, especially among brothers and sisters in the church. Mother's Day can so clearly be the best day, or the most difficult day for people. There are many reasons why it can be difficult. This is such a great reminder that the church is made up of all kinds of people with all kinds of backgrounds and stories.

7. How can Proverbs 12:25 help us? Any other passages you can add, that bring encouragement to those that may not be having their best day? (Not just on a holiday, like MD, but on any given day!)

Let's pray for those in our fellowship and those who have yet to meet Jesus, that we would be honoring and sensitive to the different needs. The best way to pray for someone is to get to know them, to hear their story and share yours. Ask God for continued opportunities. This too will honor God.
