1. What does this statement mean to you?
2. Tell of a time you knew God had given you a specific job to do. What was it like? (perhaps not a single event, but an area of service, a commitment to doing His work)
3. Compare Luke 9:1-2 with 9:10-11? What is similar, what is different?

4. Why did Jesus take the disciples out of town? (Luke 9:10; Mark 6:30-32) What were they expecting?
5. Do you have time to rest and think clearly? How important is it that we take a Sabbath rest? How often do you try to be alone and rest in the Lord? If you're up for it, share what that's like for you.
6. Jesus did not retreat when the crowd showed up, instead He had what for them? Mark 6:34

7. Sometimes we serve God because we know we should. How can we find our service to the Lord rooted in compassion for others? What are some ways to nurture that kind of heart?

8. What do you think of that statement? Have you seen it in your life? Share.
9. Why do we usually see our circumstance as our own doing instead of seeing that God has placed us right where we are?
10. How will our thinking change once we begin to see God's sovereignty in our daily routines?
11. From this story, what does the Lord ask of us? How small did the boy's lunch seem compared to the need?
12. What do you think the Lord is saying to you through this lesson?
