To Invite Others

...Requires making an adjustment to the Sunday Morning schedule.

The primary entry point for our invited guests is through one of our Large Group Worship Services. Having service times that are practical (not too early, not too late) offers each of us the best chance to receive a “Yes” from those we invite. We believe the 9:45AM and 11:00AM time slots provide the greatest opportunity for growth via personal invitation.

...Requires a critical study of what we do well and how many resources are required to continue to do well.

There are a few guiding principles that are used to help us define the best options for our Worship Service Schedule.

1. Creating engaging environments in all styles of Worship is important.
2. Everything, no matter the style or format, should support the Biblical teaching that occurs in all our services.
3. We want those who we invite to feel comfortable and welcome no matter what service they attend. Overcrowded spaces are as equally negative as spaces with more than enough room.

...Means equal attention is given to Small Groups.

Combining services and adding services displaces the critical element of Small Groups. However, this does allow for multiple Small Group options and provides space for new growth within our Small Group Ministries. While the majority of our Adult Small Groups will simply switch their meeting time with their preferred Worship time, some Small Groups may choose to multiply and create new groups. The choice will be that of the Small Group and their leadership.

The most significant opportunity will be found in our Children and Student Ministries, where more adult teachers and leaders will be able to find places to serve.
