Belong, Believe, Become

Belong – Highly relational ministry by loving and caring adults, when a child looks at church it should say to that child you belong here, and you should see Jesus through our actions. This will open the child's heart to hear and open their hearts to trust God.

Believe is deeply scriptural ministry rooted in the truth of Gods word and the power of the Gospel. A believing church says to that child you can count on Jesus and his work on the Cross. A ministry that emphasizes scripture as the foundation of their world view draws children to believe the word of the bible, especially that Jesus loves them and died for them.

Become is truly experiential ministry, designed to move kids from simulation to real world application in faith-based living, a becoming church says to that child, we will walk along side you as you navigate life.

When leaders helping the children navigate the shifting culture of life, they become resilient disciples who grow up as Christ followers and will not break under the weight of the secular culture

Club Attendance

Clubbers should attend faithfully throughout the year.

Please arrive between <u>6:00 - 6:10pm</u> for sign-in and to be ready for Awana club to start at 6:15pm.

Participation

Every clubber is expected to participate in all aspects of the program. Each Club has a goal to complete 1 book per year, which can only be accomplished by attending each week.

Dress & Shoes

Once a clubber has earned a uniform, it should be kept clean and worn each week. Wearing their uniform and sturdy shoes is one way they can earn awards to be used at the store later in the year. Closed toed/heel shoes are essential for clubbers protection when playing the Awana games.

Facilities

All clubbers are expected to stay within the areas designated by their leaders. We ask that the children stay away from areas that are not well lit. This includes the playground after dark. Once a clubber has been dismissed to a responsible adult we are no longer responsible for their safety.
